3. Marilyn introduced Shelby Township Parks and Recreation Committee co-chairs, Tammy Carey and Peg Gramas, who proceeded to discuss the purpose of tonight's hearing regarding the 5-year Recreation Plan proposal for Board approval.
4. The overview of the plan is to promote physical and psychological benefits to the community by offering them a place to have access to walking trails, sports fields, picnic areas. The plan will need to be reviewed and renewed every 5 years, with this one needing to be approved Feb. 1, 2021.
5. Robert Ford of LAP+Creative, walked through the 5-year Plan. Information from the survey given by the Rec. Committee will be added to the plan. The planning process has been followed with the first input meeting on 12/21/20, followed by the 30-day plan review, and now the final public hearing and adoption by the Township Board on 1/22/2021.
6. The Shelby Township Recreation Community Park will also be a new trailhead for the Hart-Montague Bike Trail.
7. Public Comments: Praise was given to the Board for embracing this idea and supporting it. Also, thanks to LAP+Creative for their help in designing the park.
8. Meeting was turned back over to Marilyn Glover for the board's consideration of the Committee's recommendation that the Board adopt the 5-year plan resolution. Motion was made by Scott Meyers and was seconded by Becky Griffin to accept the 5-year plan resolution. Roll call vote: Scott – yes, Becky – yes, Marilyn – yes, Cindy – yes, Absent: Richard Raffaelli. Motion was granted unanimously.
